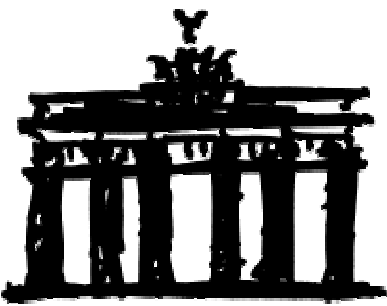

Berlin: Literature, Film, History, and Politics



After Germany's reunification in 1990, Berlin has once again become a vibrant capital and a center of German and European politics. In this course, we will employ an interdisciplinary approach to follow Berlin's history from the Weimar Republic,

through the Nazi period and World War II, the Cold War and the division of the city, to the reunification. Pending interest from students, this course will be followed by a trip to Berlin during spring break 2009.
